Item 8.01 Other Events

The E.W. Scripps Company ("Scripps") expects at least \$130 million of political advertising revenue from the 2018 midterm election season. That figure reflects an increase of 73 percent over the last midterm elections in 2014. It is also \$17 million more than Scripps said it expected in a press release issued on Sept. 21, 2018. The increases are driven by tightly contested races in a number of key Scripps local media markets.
